Background

The South West Regional Organising Committee are the people who run Adult Male League Rugby on a Saturday. It's membership is made up of representatives of the 8 CB's in the region, with a Chair who is elected into office by those on the Committee.

The committee reports directly to Twickenham and covers an area from Cornwall up to Buckinghamshire. It has the most number of teams of any ROC in the country , with around 4000 fixtures per season, scheduled.
